## Description of Change to the Customer:

### Reason for Revision: Clarification for Changes

Intel is making modifications to the Intel(R) Server System SR1530SH that will make it easier to install the DVDRROM into the system. These changes include:

- 1.Redesign of the DVD/CD drive right bracket so that it slides into the system easier
- 2.The mounting hole on the left HDD drive bracket has been modified to line up with the new DVD/CD drive bracket
- 3.The stand-off to support the DVD/CD drive height has been slightly reduced to support the new DVD bracket
4. One additional screw has been added to the screw bag found in the system accessory bag
