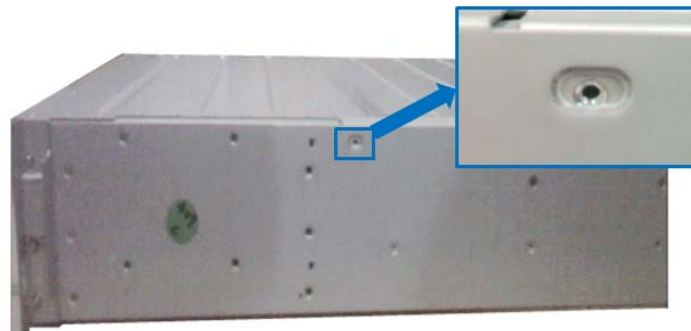

## Description of Change to the Customer:

The Intel® Server System SR2612UR will be updated to add two additional screw holes on either side of the chassis to provide support for third party security purpose tamper-proof seals.

The following picture shows the location of one of the additional screw holes at right side of the chassis as an example. A similar screw hole will also be present on the left side of the chassis.



Two additional screws will be required for third party tamper-proof seal installation, and they will be shipped with the server system. Customers can install the two additional screws if this feature is needed.

## Customer Impact of Change and Recommended Action:

Intel does not foresee any adverse customer impact from these changes. Intel recommends that the customer perform a standard level of evaluation as updated product become available, if this feature is required.
