Subsequently, customer requests for a specific revision of material (below the MM#) will not be supported by Intel.

Description of Change to the Customer:

Intel is implementing the following change on the Intel® Server System R1208JP4OC:

Update the firmware of the 450W Power Supply Unit (PSU) to align PSU behavior with the rest of the Intel Common Redundant Power Supplies (CRPS).

In the previous firmware the Over Current Protection (OCP) latch could be released by using PS-ON signal from BMC. In the new firmware this functionality will not be supported anymore. The method to release the latch by removing and re-inserting the AC power cord still will be maintained.

Table-1 shows the pre-change and post-change Top Assembly numbers for the PSUs
